Context

“**The** witness to the gospel of our lord Jesus Christ should be made by verbal proclamation as well social action” with this theme a consultation was held in 1989 to enter in the field of social services. Hence a board was constituted. The board focused mainly on the areas of literacy, Health, fundamental rights, agriculture, status of women and political awareness .The mission behind establishing Diocesan Board of Social Services was to strengthen the political, social and economical status of poor through collective struggle so that they may live comfortably and honorably, From this DBSS wants to materialize the philosophy of an ideal society where there is justice, equality unity & peace. DBSS took the mission into action catering to the needs of Dalits & Marginalized people.

Earlier DBSS worked through charity based institutional support; the necessity and circumstances changed its approaches. In the year 2000, right-based approach was adopted. In the beginning, many obstacles emerged because the reference community could not internalize and accept this approach. But DBSS did not surrender. It kept on working hard on this approach, and at last the reference community was awakened, educated & mobilized. Presently DBSS involved with struggle of the people in three regions namely Surajpura, Kekri and Ashapura covering 4244 families of 45 villages with 45 village Development committees, 9 Cluster Development committees, and 3 Area development committees and also 25 SHG’s and 2 field area congregations. The reference area is

spread in the district of Ajmer. Developmental work is progressing in 14 Gram Panchayats, 5 Panchayat Samiti and 3 Blocks.

At present the level of People's Organization is limited. They participate in the activities of planning process, implementation and monitoring; they have also mobilized the Govt-resources through collective struggle. The women attached with SHG's have gain economic benefits and now they are engaged in the occupation, which help them to earn their livelihood. The political base of People's Organization has strengthened a lot. In the last Panchayat election 6 (female) Surpanch, 6 (Male) Upsarpanch, 22 (Male) & 14 (Female) ward panch were elected from reference community. This is the result of collective efforts, but more efforts have to make yet for the community development.

Keeping in mind the main objective, it is not merely to bring awareness by empowering the people but also to get them their rights so that the oppressed and the marginalized know the system of exploitation and the strategy of exploiters and by mutual cooperation. The oppressed may bring their own salvation in the present patterns of the society.

Objectives

1. To develop and consolidate database on specific thematic (issue-based) interventions - land rights, tribal identity, livelihood and food security, Self-Help Groups(SHG)s, and federations, cooperatives, people's organizations and movements through guiding frameworks. This database would provide guiding frameworks for planning and monitoring and impact assessment.
2. To enable DBSSs Coordinators and Resource Centre (RC) s to maintain dynamic database. Facilitate awareness on the relevance and use of scientific

data among various stakeholders. As instrument knowledge data can be effectively used for various purposes such as visibilising issues, building alliances and lobbying, benchmarking micro and macro trends, establishing linkages etc.

3. To use database for developing Management of Information Systems (MIS)

The First Round

Process and Purpose

7. Dalit and Livelihood: Access and Control to Resources: Interventions and Impact

Context of DBSS: The reference community consists of mostly the marginal farmers, landless laborers and Dalit, Rawat, Gurjur, Bairwa, Jat and other backward caste inhabit the area. There are no proper facilities for health care, education and public distribution system in the reference community. 75% of is dependant on agriculture. Since the reference area touches the desert of Rajasthan, monsoon is affected and the rainfall is scanty. Irregular rainfall makes agriculture difficult for the farmers and during the last 5 years . The landless laborers did not even get the minimum wages as prescribed from the govt. The ill effect of child marriage, drunkenness, traditionalism, untouchable, casteism and ceremonial feasts after death is much. Reference community is not been able to elect representatives from their own community and the elected representatives from other higher class manipulate the govt. facilities floated to the public, the problems and issues of reference community remain the same leaving them to bare it. The panchayat raj system is well established in the villages but due to ignorance in the reference community the economically strong upper case people hold leadership in the village panchayat. Male & Female difference prevail in the reference community. The men socially, economically and politically exploit the women. Women are not sensitive towards local self government; therefore they have not enough strong political bases to resist the exploitative forces and no enough power to raise voice against the system. They receive fewer wages than their male counterpart. In some places girls are kept away from education to help in the domestic work because of that the literacy rate of female in Rajasthan state is below National average.
