Paradigm Shift from Aid Effectiveness - Development Effectiveness

Action of Churches Together Alliance (ACT Alliance) is a new initiative of the World Council of Churches. CNI-SBSS being a participant member of the Alliance since its formation has country ownership of development, aligning their aid with country's national development strategies. Harmonizing and managing work and actions for better results and promoting mutual accountability.

As civil society organizations, ACT members are recognized as an important part of development cooperation efforts. ACT Alliance has established a Working Group on Development Effectiveness to carry forward cooperation among its members. CNI-SBSS is a member of this Working Group representing the southern partners from Asia.

The Working Group on behalf of the ACT Alliance and WCC with civil societies representatives around the world are calling on donor and recipient governments to look beyond Aid-Effectiveness to the goal of Development Effectiveness. It calls for effective participation in Better Aid Consulting Group (BACG) and open forum of Civil Societies Organization towards preparation of a high level open forum meeting in 2010. ACT participants would participate in forthcoming regional workshops promoting multi-stakeholder partnership for democratic development processes and enabling environment for local ownership and accountability.

To take the process forward ACT India Forum came together in Delhi on August 27th to Introduce Impact Assessment project of ACT Development to the member organisations and Explore opportunities for collective actions with ACT-D partners in India to take the Impact Assessment initiative forward through a ACT India Forum.
