Mainstreaming LCP in CNI SBSS

LCP was brought into CNI-SBSS and incubated till 2004 and actual process happened from February 2005 after Bangkok LCP Regional Coordination Committee meeting. It is in this meeting the organization accepted the philosophy DNH and later mandated to take advantage of [LCP framework](#) to put in practice. CNI-SBSS built the environment for LCP in the organization alongwith building leadership on LCP and mainstreaming or integrating in the organizational PME system.

Taking the opportunity of the current project 2005-08 "Let Justice Roll", and as CNI-SBSS strategically work on the issues related Right to Land, Livelihood, Food Security and Social Exclusion of Tribals and Dalits communities. It is realized that projects in the North East India, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Orissa in particular are part of structured conflicts and sometimes violent in nature mostly rooted to socio-political and economic reasons. In the process of ensuring justice and peace became mar and it requires in-depth analysis, redefining the roles of NGOs. It is also must to adopt unusual strategies if one NGO must work in conflict settings. Therefore, [LCP framework](#) was introduced in 2005 which enabled situational analysis of conflicts and recommit to uphold non-violent resistance.

CNI-SBSS is has been a resource sharing and development support agency, working through the CNI-RCSA located at Agra, Barrackpore, Pune and Ranchi strategically. They provide technical and program support including perspectives, vision building, contextual theology and new mission praxis to the DBSS its project implementing partners. DBSS mainly works in people's empowerment on issues. Worth mentioning, is working towards enhancing the capacity of people's movement as a socio-bargaining force.
