

1.2.3 Situation - CNI SBSS, a collective form of cooperation

The CNI SBSS is development and justice wing of the Church of North India. To fulfil the mission of the church.. in spirit of sacrifice and spirit of Christ CNI SBSS, for 30 years is involved with communities across the north India. It has team of more than 30 dedicated development professionals passionate about justice and equality.

CNI SBSS supports dioceses of the Church (more than 20 at present) to engage with communities to sensitise them about their rights. DBSS are independent though receive support and advice from SBSS. They are accountable to the diocese. CNI Resource Centres for Social Actions (presently 4 at Agra, Pune, Kolkata and Ranchi) accompanies diocese and develops issue base response across CNI. Based on Contextual theology CNIRCSA develops mission praxis and practice in their partnership with the Diocese.

CNI SBSS with it's headquarter at Delhi is involve in policy, campaigns and research and network all DBSS and RCSA for maximum impact of their initiatives. Based on research and analysis of field situation, the campaigns of SBSS aim to contribute in policy formulations and its implementation in favour of poor. SBSS is an active member of ACT Development and FCFC.
